AXA Corporate Solutions and Uber Eats launched insurance package for independent couriers in several European countries

- Uber Eats and AXA Corporate Solutions today announced a partnership to provide additional protection and security for couriers who partner with Uber Eats in nine European countries: (Austria, Belgium, Italy, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Spain, Sweden and UK).

As part of several initiatives between Uber and AXA, Uber Eats and AXA Corporate Solutions have created a new insurance package designed to specifically cater to the needs of couriers who use the Uber Eats app to access flexible earning opportunities.

The package is the first of its kind to provide protection across multiple countries, offering coverage for personal accidents, cash benefit due to hospitalization and cover for third party injury and property damage to couriers who hold an active Uber Eats account in EU member countries where the food delivery app operates.

Personal accident during an Uber Eats trip

- Reimbursement for medical expenses from an accident that results in hospitalization (hospital costs and also all the related consultation costs, pharmaceutical costs, X-rays and medical tests up to €7,500).
- If the hospitalization is of 3 consecutive nights (72 hours) or more, a lump sum payment of €3,000 will be made.
- In case of permanent total disability, a lump sum payment will be made of €30,000.
- In case of accidental death, a lump sum payment will be made to the beneficiary of €30,000 as well as reimbursing up to €3,000 for costs relating to funeral expenses.

Cash benefit for severe sickness or injury

- If an active Uber Eats courier suffers from any severe sickness or injury leading to hospitalization of more than 3 consecutive days (72 hours), the courier will receive €50 for each day they are confirmed medically unable to work (up to a maximum of 15 days).



Third party cover during an Uber Eats trip

- Coverage for any legal liabilities for bicycle (or pedestrian) couriers relating to third party bodily injuries and third party property damage up to a maximum of €1,000,000.

“We believe everyone should have the option to protect themselves against rare and unforeseen work accidents that prevent them from earning a living. That’s why we’re pleased to launch a first of its kind insurance package designed for independent couriers who work in EU markets where we operate.

Uber Eats couriers can now enjoy the freedom and flexibility of working on their own schedule with the peace of mind provided by additional security and protection. This is a reflection of our commitment to invest in solutions that meet the everyday needs and concerns of couriers who want to partner with Uber Eats to earn some extra money,” **said Filip Nuytemans, Uber Eats General Manager, Europe.**

“We are excited to partner with Uber Eats to offer independent couriers using their application additional protection and security through our innovative insurance package. The new insurance package from AXA Corporate Solutions will be offered free of charge from January 2018 to all independent couriers holding an Uber Eats account in nine EU markets where Uber Eats operates. In the event of an accident, the courier will simply have to fill in an online claim form available via the Uber Eats app.
